Seniors in these areas have diverse needs, with 11% of those 60+ in Central Texas experiencing difficulty with mobility, and 40% reporting challenges with heavy housework. Moreover, 20% of residents 75 and older do not own or drive a car, emphasizing the necessity for accessible transportation options.

It's not just about providing a service; it's about enriching lives with dignity and respect," says Stacey K Eisenberg.
